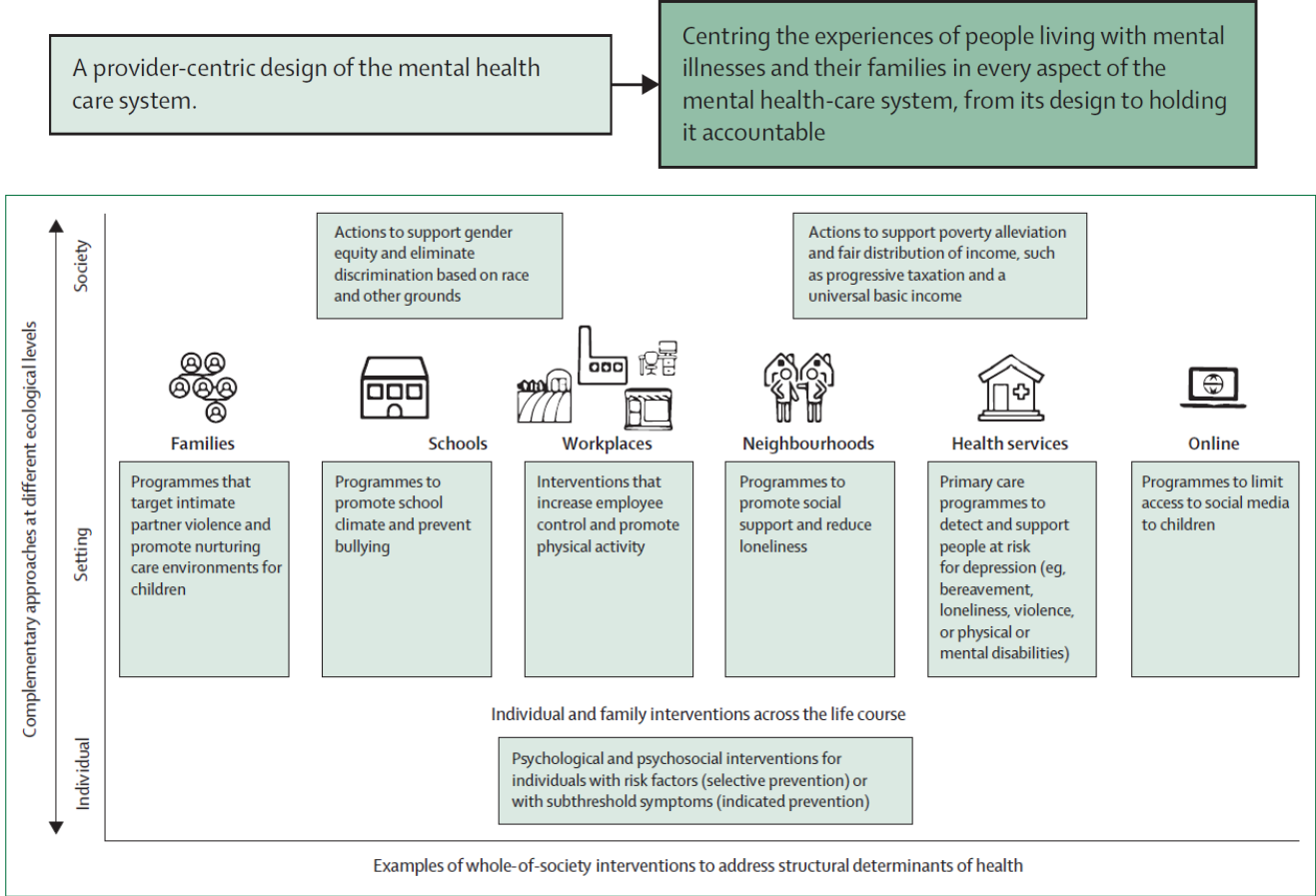


Figure 2: Whole of society interventions to address structural determinants of health

# Actions

- Establish a good pattern of communication with different stakeholders (mainly people with lived experience)
- How to accommodate different expectations from different stakeholders
- Survey to meet those expectations from different stakeholders
  - Helping in designing experiments, analysis, and potential products aligned with stakeholders' expectations (considering cultural diversity)
- Disseminate the consortium and create opportunities to work with other societal sectors than academia.

- Communicate scientific papers to a broader audience



# Examples

- Facilitate diverse PPI research by being a point of contact for recruitment
- Facilitate feasibility, usability and UX studies for industry
- Navigate industry-led collaborations
- Harmonise research protocols, measures and outcomes
